## PRESS RELEASE

The National Anti-Corruption Commission (CONAC) will on Friday, April 27, 2018, in Bertoua, Headquarters of the East Region, organise a caravan to mobilise and sensitize workers, most especially those of the public service, on the damages caused by corruption and the role they should play in the fight against the cankerworm. The caravan, which falls in line with activities marking the commemoration of the 2018 edition of the International Labour Day, seeks to draw the attention of workers on the need to serve the public selflessly. CONAC is also out to seek popular support for the fight against corruption to enable Cameroon to attain its critical mass of positive actors ready to say "NO" to the scourge.

The caravan will be launched by the Governor of the East Region and the Chairman of CONAC. The event, in the Conference Hall of the Governor's Office, will take place in the presence of administrative, judicial, traditional and religious authorities of Bertoua.

The caravan will drive through the main streets of Bertoua, stopping at all administrative offices to paste anti-corruption boards, as well as at road junctions, markets and motor parks, to distribute information gadgets and sensitise the public on the need to fight against corruption.

The Chairman of CONAC seizes this opportunity to enjoin Cameroonians of all walks of life to be more committed to the fight against corruption in a bid to guarantee the development of the nation, which is the major objective of the policy of emergence championed by the Head of State, His Excellency Paul BIYA.
