



**INSTALLATION OF INTEGRITY CLUBS IN UNIVERSITIES  
AND PUBLIC AND PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

**Terms of Reference**

**Background**

Integrity Clubs were created and installed by CONAC in 2016 in some State Universities. The aim of these clubs was to mobilize the university community against corrupt practices and to adopt integrity as a core value.

Four years down the line, some of these Clubs, which served as a link between CONAC and the student community, disappeared because their leaders had left the University. This situation is detrimental to the fight against corruption in this milieu. Conversely, Article 13 of CONAC's constituting instrument requires the institution to "raise awareness and inform the public on the anti-corruption drive" and to "inform the public on activities to prevent and combat corruption."

To restore vigour in the Clubs, CONAC held a meeting at its headquarters in Yaoundé with leaders of the Integrity Clubs of State Universities and other Public and Private Institutions of Higher Education, on 15 October 2020.

At this meeting, participants were requested to set up Integrity Clubs in their institutions upon their return. CONAC is visiting three weeks later to install the members of these Clubs and give them their roadmap.

**General Objective**

Generally, the aim of this activity is to revitalize the Integrity Clubs for more efficient integrity education, a prerequisite for the training of young people in the fight against corruption.

**Specific objectives**

The specific objectives are:

- to sensitize the education community on principles and values of integrity;
- to rally the education community around the issues and challenges of promoting integrity in youth environment;
- to create a group of positive actors committed to the fight against corruption in universities and other Public and Private Institutions of Higher Education.

**Expected results**

Install all Higher Education Integrity Clubs have and make them operational so as to serve as focal points in the fight against corruption in their institutions.

**Target**

Leaders of Integrity Clubs in State Universities and Public and Private Higher Education Institutions.

**Date and Venue**

Integrity Club installation in the city of Buea will take place on Tuesday 16 February 2021 in the different institutions that have created these Clubs.
